Marsha Parker is describing her hip surgery performed by Dr. Douglas Bolda, orthopedic surgeon at Crawford County Memorial Hospital, and her subsequent recovery.

“My husband and I had just moved from Omaha into Dow City. We had been living there approximately six weeks. We had just gotten a new puppy and I fell over him, three times. I didn’t think anything of it the first time. The second time I was a little sore, and I got really sore the third time I fell. By then my husband rushed me to the ER because I was in a lot of pain and I could not walk.”

“He got me up to the hospital (CCMH) and Dr. Bolda and the ER doctors got together and came in and told me that I had broken my right hip and had fractured my pelvis in two areas, and that I needed surgery.”

Following surgery, Parker spent several days in the hospital recovering.
